DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That the Carrier violated the current agreement when they:

(a) Improperly assigned other than carmen to perform carmen's work.

(b) Refused to compensate employees at the applicable hourly rate, straight time hours, overtime for overtime hours for all hours spent by other than carmen to perform this work.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
