DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: Claim that Rule 52 of the current agreement was violated when other than Rock Island employees were used to perform the work enumerated in the rule, and that the employees who should have been used be compensated for all time worked by other than regular employees.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
