**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** (a) That Machinist E. O. Parkman, Marshall, Texas, was unjustly removed from car journal turning lathe without a hearing or investigation.

(b) That he be restored to his former position on said journal turning lathe.
