DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: That under the current agreement the mechanical foreman has been improperly substituted for Machinist M. C. Tidwell, who was laid off on October 26, 1946, and that accordingly the carrier be ordered to restore Machinist Tidwell to service with compensation for all time lost retroactive to said date.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

Claim dismissed.
