PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 6, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L. (Carmen)**

CHICAGO, ROCK ISLAND AND PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1—That the assignment of bridge and building employes to paint and stencil Rock Island bunk car 95752 and Rock Island diner car 95745, at Iowa City, Iowa, September 8, 9, 10, 14 and 15, 1949 was not proper or authorized under the current agreement.

2—That accordingly the carrier be ordered to additionally compensate Carmen Painters George Nelson and Nick Leon at the applicable rate for the number of hours these bridge and building employes were used on the afore-said work, dividing the amount due equally between them.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
