**AMERICAN REFRIGERATOR TRANSIT COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:**

1—That under the current agreement Carman M. C. Ries was unjustly dealt with when the carrier denied him compensation for the period 3:00 P. M. to 4:30 P. M., on April 3, 1951, the time he was off to vote as provided by the Missouri State Law.

2—That accordingly the carrier be ordered to compensate the aforementioned carman for the aforesaid period making him whole.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, a hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

**AWARD**

Claim dismissed.
