RAILWAY EXPRESS AGENCY, INC.

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1. That under the current agreement Machinist L. S. Wakefield was unjustly dismissed from the service effective April 1st, 1950.

2. That accordingly the Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, be ordered to reinstate this employe in the service and pay him for all time lost.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing was held thereon, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
