THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD COMPANY
(Central Region)

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1. That the Carrier is not authorized under the Controlling Agreement to assign employees in the Pitcairn seniority district to the duties of which accrue to employees in the Derry Seniority District.

2. That the Carrier be ordered to compensate Claimant Car Inspectors, R. W. Singer and F. B. Lowe in the amount of eight (8) hours pay each at the time and one-half rate for January 7, 1953.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
