**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That under the current agreement other than Locomotive Supplymen were improperly assigned to supply locomotives on March 28, April 1, 4, 7, 10, and 12, 1955.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to additionally compensate the following Laborers in the amount of 8 hours' pay at the applicable rate for each date set forth after their name:
