**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly declined to bulletin the vacancy created when Electrician T. J. Johnson was assigned the position of Federal Inspector under Bulletin No. 8.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to bulletin the vacancy referred to above.
