**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 99, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'**  
**DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L.-C. I. O. (Carmen)**

**ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:** (1) That under the current agreement Carman Helper C. P. Wiggins, was unjustly deprived of his contractual right to eight (8) hours, holiday pay on July 4, 1955.

(2) That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate Carman Helper C. P. Wiggins, in the amount of eight (8) hours pay at the straight time rate as Holiday Pay for July 4, 1955.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
