**LOUISVILLE AND NASHVILLE RAILROAD COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:** 1. That the Carrier violated the terms of the current agreement when on December 16, 1953 they sup-  
planted carmen with foreman and others at Bowling Green, Kentucky.

2. a) That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to restore a  
sufficient number of Carmen, and

b) Compensate them (Carmen) 8 hours for each shift  
subsequent to 7:30 A. M., December 16, 1953.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Divi-  
sion of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred  
organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request  
from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
