**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 97, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L.-C. I. O. (Electrical Workers)**

ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1. That under the current agreement, the Carrier erred when they did not assign Electrician, Mr. S. B. Sikora to inspect the electrical equipment, (namely the electric motors, generators and wiring thereto), on cars PFE 61700-44834-40793-45265-8798-9563-41105-44139 and 41122, July 10, 1955.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Electrician Mr. S. B. Sikora, four (4) hours at his regular hourly rate of pay for this assignment violation.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to Organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
