**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:** 1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly refused to properly bulletin and describe duties of jobs when bulletined on April 14, 1954.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to bulletin jobs or vacancies so that they might be identifiable for the purpose of exercising seniority.
