**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 99, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L.-C. I. O. (Carmen)**

ILLINOIS CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: 1. That under the current agreement that other than Carmen were improperly assigned to inspect and make repairs to air brakes on Multiple Unit cars at the Randolph Street Station, on December 26, 1955, and on January 2, 1956.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate Carmen H. M. Lutz and J. H. Rodeghier for 8 hours each at the applicable time and one-half rate for the aforesaid violation.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
