**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Shop Craft Employees of the Sheet Metal Workers' Water Service Employees to install, trim and fit metal cupboards, metal cabinets, metal sinks and metal lockers in the New Laboratory Building at Springfield, Missouri.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to additionally compensate the hereinafter named Water Service Employees eight (8) hours each at the applicable straight time rate of pay for each and every day that other than Water Service Employees were used to perform the work described in part one of this Claim.
