**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 45, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'  
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L.-C. I. O. (Carmen)**

**ST. LOUIS-SOUTHWESTERN RAILWAY LINES**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:**

1. That under the rules of the controlling agreement and the Articles of the Vacation Agreement, particularly Article 7, Carrier violated the agreement when they refused to allow Car Inspector H. A. Sander the same compensation while on vacation December 19 through 30, 1955 that he earned while on his regular assignment.

2. That, accordingly, Carrier be ordered to compensate Car Inspector Sander one hour each day for December 20, 21, 22, 23, 27, 28, 29 and 30, 1955.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to Organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

Claim dismissed.
