DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement upgraded Carman J. R. Dotson was unjustly dismissed from the service on March 23, 1956.

2. That, accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to reinstate him in the service with all rights unimpaired and with compensation for all time lost retroactive to the aforesaid date.
