- 1. That under the current agreement carrier improperly furloughed senior electrical apprentices M. R. Smeltzer, C. C. MacDonald and R. L. Smith at the Roundhouse at Cumberland, Maryland on July 6, 1956.
- 2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to return the aforesaid employes to service and compensate them for all time lost from July 6, 1956 to the date of return to service.
