**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 88, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'  
DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Boilermakers)**

**ELGIN, JOLIET & EASTERN RAILWAY COMPANY**

**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:**

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Boilermakers the work of restoring hatch doors with the aid of a crane, on Locomotive No. 406.

2. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned members of the Sheet Metal Workers' Craft to fill Locomotive No. 406 with water.

3. That Boilermaker J. Whalen and Boilermaker Helper J. Bates be compensated for four (4) hours each at straight time rate.

**STATEMENT:** The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
