DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement it was improper to substitute Carmen from Hartford, Connecticut, together with a truck with a winch attachment, property of the Sherman Sand and Gravel Company, New Britain, Connecticut, to rerail New Britain Yard Switcher Engine No. 0816.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to compensate the following named, regularly assigned members of the New Haven, Connecticut Tool Train:
