## DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:

- 1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department to repair drop cords and lights from overhead circuits about twenty feet from the floor in the paint shop at Burnside Shops, Chicago, Illinois, on October 17, 1957, thereby damaging Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department in the amount of two hours penalty time, and that accordingly,
- 2. The following regularly employed employes of the Carrier of the Maintenance of Equipment Department be compensated at the applicable time and one-half rate for each man hour worked which they were entitled to perform under the applicable rules of the current agreement:
