DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department for replacing fluorescent lights in Diesel Shop at Burnside Shops, Chicago, Illinois on October 18, 1957, thereby damaging Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department in the amount of two hours per man at penalty time, and that accordingly,

2. The following regularly employed employees of the Carrier of the Maintenance of Equipment Department be compensated at the applicable time and one-half rate for each man hour worked which they were entitled to perform under the applicable rules of the current agreement:
