DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:

1. That under the current agreement the carrier improperly assigned other than Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department, to install light fixtures in storehouse office at Burnside Shops on January 2, 1958, thereby damaging Electrical Workers of the Maintenance of Equipment Department in the amount of four hours of work at penalty rate, and that, accordingly,

2. The following regularly employed employe of the carrier of the Maintenance of Equipment Department be compensated at the applicable time and one-half rate for each man hour worked which they were entitled to perform under the applicable rule of the agreement:
