**DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES:**

1. That under the current agreement the Carrier improperly assigned other than Boilermakers to the work of fitting together and welding of smoke stack and breeching at its Sedalia, Missouri Powerhouse from July 9 to July 23, 1958, both dates inclusive.

2. That accordingly the Carrier be ordered to additionally compensate the following named Boilermakers equally for 162 hours at the applicable Boilermaker Welder's rate (108 hours at the time and one-half rate) for the aforesaid violation:
