The work done by the Youngstown wreck crew belongs to the McKees Rocks, Pa. wreck crew. Since the Youngstown wreck crew was used the Organization requests that the following men from the McKees Rocks wreck crew be paid for all time worked by the Youngstown employes: J. Plascjak, S. Filipovitz, M. Novoselski, G. McBane, F. Kownacki, A. Stacko, J. Stangl, A. Palahulik and R. Schutz."

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in exparte form, hearing thereon was held, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employes that the case be withdrawn.
