SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 101, RAILWAY EMPLOYES'
DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L. - C. I. O. (Carmen)

GREAT NORTHERN RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYES: 1. That the current agreement was violated when the Carrier failed to compensate Carmen R. L. Richey and Charles Meisner for time waiting to return to home point on September 20, 1960.

2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Carmen R. L. Richey and Charles Meisner ten and one-half (10½) hours each at the time and one-half rate for September 20, 1960.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was not held, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.

AWARD

Claim dismissed.
