DEPARTMENT, A. F. of L. — C. I. O. (Carmen)

NORFOLK AND WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES: That the Carrier violated the current agreement on the following dates, 3-3-62, 3-10-62, 3-17-62 and 3-19-62, account working an Apprentice who was not retained in the service of the Carrier after completion of his Apprenticeship, and given a seniority date, as a carman, per-Rule No. 41 and Rule No. 30. Therefore, a claim for eight (8) hours pay at the rate of time and one-half be allowed for the following Car-men, C. W. Carawan—3-3-62, W. J. Ermen—3-10-62, J. R. Williams—3-17-62, and H. M. Conn—3-19-62.

STATEMENT: The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
