PARTIES TO DISPUTE:

**SYSTEM FEDERATION NO. 16, RAILWAY EMPLOYEES'
DEPARTMENT, AFL-CIO (Carmen)**

NORFOLK AND WESTERN RAILWAY COMPANY

DISPUTE: CLAIM OF EMPLOYEES:

1. That the carrier violated Article III of the August 19, 1960 agreement when they denied holiday pay for July 4, 1963 to the following employees,

Car Repairer W. A. Moore,
Apprentice Car Repairer D. W. Tabor
employed at Bluefield Shop, Bluefield, West Virginia.

2. That accordingly the carrier be ordered to compensate the aforesaid claimants 8 hour's pay for July 4, 1963.

FINDINGS: The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute were given due notice of hearing thereon.

The factual situation and issues for determination in this dispute were presented to this Division in Award 5061, and said award being controlling this claim will be sustained.

AWARD

Claim sustained.
