2. That accordingly, Carrier be ordered to correct the 1971 Seniority Roster of the Laundry employees employed at Western Avenue, by returning L. C. Foshee's name, with original Seniority dates, to the 1971 Seniority Roster for Laundry employees of Western Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.
