Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That under the terms of the controlling agreement, the Illinois Terminal Railroad Company violated Rule 15 when it bulletined machinist position No.-F-5136 on August 11, 1975, showing monthly rate of \$1287.13.
2. That Machinist J. H. Worthy who bid in and was assigned Position 213 effective August 16, 1975, was improperly compensated.
3. That, accordinally, the Illinois Terminal Railroad Company be ordered to increase the monthly rate to \$1436.22, effective September 1, 1975. In addition, wage increases as provided in National Wage Agreements including cost of living adjustments be applied when they occur, all of this based on a Monthly Rate of \$1436.22, September 1, 1975.
4. It is further requested that the Illinois Terminal Railroad be ordered to pay the full increases in wage rates due this assignment retroactive to September 1, 1975.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
