System Federation No. 109, Railway Employes' Department, A. F. of L. (Carmen) Parties to Dispute:

Consolidated Rail Corporation

Claim of Employes: Dispute:

- That the Carrier violated the controlling agreement when on July 29, 1976, it assessed a five days actual suspension, August 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20, 1976, to Car Repairer David L. Knarr, ConRail Repair Facility, Reading, Pennsylvania, as a result of a hearing and investigation conducted on July 27, 1976.
- (b) That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to compensate Car Repairer David L. Knarr the five days actual suspension plus 1-1/2 hours for attending the hearing, plus remove the five days actual suspension from his service record.

Findings:

The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employe within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The decision reached in companion Award 7870 is dispositive of this case. We find no evidence that the five (5) days suspension was improperly imposed of inconsistent with the record.

We will deny the claim.

AWARD

Claim denied.
