That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rules 3, 4-Section 1 (a), 5 (a), 6 (a), and 7 (a), (d) and (g) of the Communications Agreement effective August 1, 1977 when they denied Communications Maintainer J. A. Hoyt at Wichita, Kansas the overtime provisions of the Agreement, i.e., two and seven-tenths (2.7') at the overtime rate for February 8, 1978.
- 2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer J. A. Hoyt two and seven-tenths hours (2.7') at the overtime rate for February 8, 1978.

Statement:
