Statement:

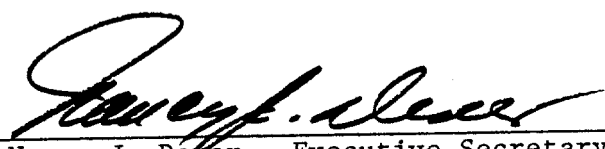
