Statement:

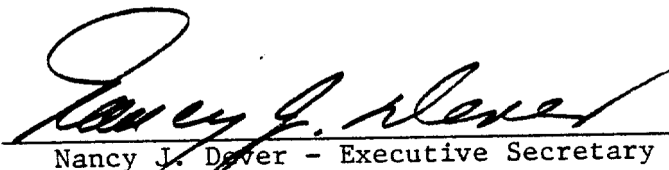
