1. That the National Railroad Passenger Corporation violated the current agreement, particularly Rule 13(f) Overtime, when it failed to assign Electrician B. Butcher to work overtime in the Passenger Car Trim Shop on November 10, 1979 at Beech Grove, Indiana.
2. That accordingly, the carrier should be ordered to additionally compensate Electrician B. Butcher with eight (8) hours pay at the applicable time and one half electricians' rate in order to make him whole.
