Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rule 24 (a) and Rule 1 of the Communications Agreement effective August 1, 1977; and, Article III of the September 25, 1964 Agreement when Carrier assigned other (a Western Union Maintainer) to perform Communications Maintainers' work on September 26 and 29, 1980, thus, depriving Communications Maintainer Heise of his contractual rights under the provisions of the Agreement.
2. That, accordingly, the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Communications Maintainer H. G. Heise eight (8) hours at the punitive rate for September 26 and 29, 1980.


Statement:
