Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Consolidated Rail Corporation violated the current agreement, especially Rule 2-A-4(b) when it failed to allow Electrician M. Hooley, Avon Indiana Diesel Terminal, an additional two (2) hours straight time pay at the applicable electrician's rate due him under Rule 2-A-4(b) when carrier assigned him to perform work not comprehended in his regular assignment on July 16, 1979, particularly to locating troubles on locomotive 8052 that activated the ground relay.
2. That accordingly the carrier should be ordered to pay Electrician M. Hooley an additional two (2) hours' pay at the applicable electrician's straight time rate due him under Rule 2-A-4(b) in order to make him whole.


Statement:
