Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Missouri Pacific Railroad Company violated Rule 5 and the NOTE therein of the June 1, 1960 controlling agreement when they denied Electricians J. T. VanHorn, D. E. Brandon, L. E. Jones, S. D. Vanderlinden, G. G. Lonon, D. E. Bourland, J. O. Stringham, D. L. Jefferson, R. W. Palmquist, Jr., R. R. Richardson, and P. E. Lamborn their contractual rights of assignment to work the holiday, January 1, 1981, thereby depriving each and every Claimant the opportunity for eight (8) hours holiday overtime pay for that holiday.
2. That, accordingly, Carrier be ordered to compensate each claimant, Electrician J. T. VanHorn, D. E. Brandon, L. E. Jones, S. D. Vanderlinden, G. G. Lonon, D. E. Bourland, J. O. Stringham, D. L. Jefferson, R. W. Palmquist, Jr., R. R. Richardson, and P. E. Lamborn, eight (8) hours each at the time and one-half rate for the Legal Holiday, New Year's Day, Thursday, January 1, 1981.

Statement:


