1. That the Louisville and Nashville Railroad company violated the current Agreement, as amended, effective September 1, 1943 when on August 29, 1980 they unjustly removed and withheld from service, through September 12, 1980, Electrician R. B. Thompson at Nashville, Tennessee.
2. That accordingly, the Louisville and Nashville Railroad Company be ordered to compensate Electrician R. B. Thompson for a total of ninety-two (92) hours at \$10.27 per hour, as specified in the claim.
