Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That in violation of the current Agreement, Electronic Technician T. H. Campbell was unjustly withheld from service of the Burlington Northern, preceding and following an investigation held on March 26, 1980.
2. That accordingly, the Carrier be ordered to make the aforementioned T. H. Campbell whole by compensating him in the amount of eight (8) hours compensation at the pro-rata rate per day for each of the 33 days he was arbitrarily withheld from Carrier service and removal of the entry of investigation and/or censure from his personal record plus compensation for or restoration of, all rights, benefits, or privileges of which he may have been deprived, during this 33 day period. Claim to begin 8:00 a.m., March 7, 1980 to and including 11:59 p.m., April 14, 1980.

Statement:


