Falker, Jr., was unjustly treated following investigation when a letter dated September 2, 1980, stating that the evidence adduced at the investigation established his responsibility for allegedly violating Rule 801 of the General Rules and REgulations of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (Pacific Lines) was made a permanent part of his personal record. Said alleged violation occurring on July 25, 1980.
- 2. That accordingly, the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (Pacific Lines) be ordered to remove the letter dated September 2, 1980, from Electrician Falker's personal record.
