Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. The Staten Island Rapid Transit Operating Authority arbitrarily violated the schedule agreement beginning August 25, 1978 and continuing thru October 17, 1978 by withholding monies earned and due certain employees as a means of discipline.
2. Accordingly, F. Bologna, J. Marsetti, L. Russo, W. Ochmann, J. Rutigliano, A. Bishop, H. Wilmers, F. Blackden, and P. Raggi should be compensated an amount equal to the amount which was withheld as a result of the violation plus interest at the rate of 6 per cent.

Statement:

The above question was submitted to the Second Division of the National Railroad Adjustment Board by the above referred to organization in ex parte form, hearing thereon was waived, and the Division is now in receipt of a request from the employees that the case be withdrawn.
