Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railway Company violated the current agreement when, on May 8, 12, 13, 22, 27, June 8, 22 and 23, 1981 employees other than a crane operator with rights on the Locomotive Shop Seniority Roster were improperly assigned to perform the operation of cranes in the Locomotive Shop.

2. That the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railway Company violated the current agreement when they failed to recall Overhead Crane Operator Edward G. Gulas to service on those days stated above and failed to provide a five (5) day notice.

3. That the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railway Company compensate Crane Operator Edward G. Gulas, Account No. 1503 for 240 hours at the straight time rate of pay account of the violation.

Statement:

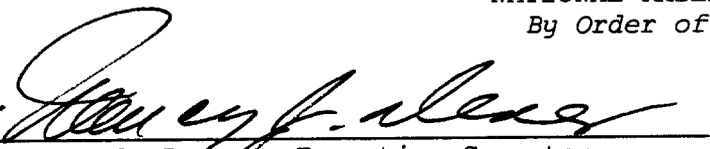
