2. That the Chicago and North Western Transportation Company be ordered to compensate Carmen J. Ericksen, G. Krajnovich, F. Miskiewicz and H. Kaiser the amount of eight (8) hours pay at time and one-half rate of pay for December 24, 1981.

Statement:


