Dispute: Claim of Employees:

1. That Laborers G. R. Foster, Sr., Thomas Williams, V. J. Anderson, J. D. Walker, F. E. Poole and E. R. Mitchell were unjustly removed from the Seniority Roster of the Johnston Car Department, Memphis, Tennessee, which resulted in the loss of seniority and wages.
2. That accordingly, the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad be ordered to restore the original seniority of the Laborers involved and to compensate the Laborers for all time lost, and all other benefits be restored that they would have been eligible for from May 7, 1981, in accord with their original seniority dates.

Statement:


