Burney and Electrician T. Cochran their contractual rights to said work under the provisions of the Agreement at Houston, Texas.
- 2. That, accordingly, Carrier be ordered to compensate Electrician J. Burney and Electrician T. Cochran eight (8) hours at the overtime rate for Sunday, November 1, 1981.
