Dispute: Claim of Employes:

- 1. That the Consolidated Rail Corporation be ordered to remove the two days suspension, deferred, from the service record of Machinist E. Fonzo.
- 2. The agreement of May 1, 1979, is controlling.

Findings:

The Second Division of the Adjustment Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The carrier or carriers and the employe or employes involved in this dispute are respectively carrier and employes within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act as approved June 21, 1934.

This Division of the Adjustment Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein.

Parties to said dispute waived right of appearance at hearing thereon.

The Board finds the facts and arguments in this claim identical to those in Award No. 9851 and accordingly reaches the same conclusion.

AWARD

Claim denied.
