Statement:

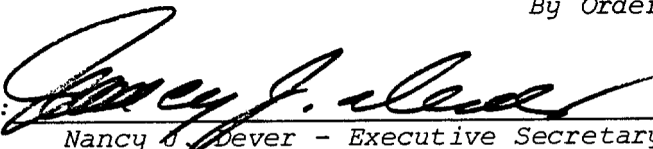
