STATEMENT:

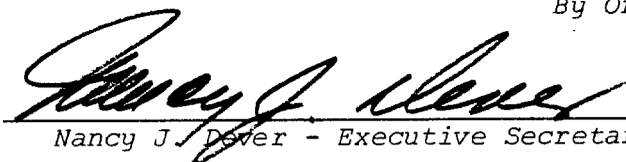
